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# **Checklist Control Day to control teams**

The first checkpoint is at the Jury table, in which the following shall be presented:

### 1. Final List Team Delegation

- > Is the list completely filled in?
- > Are the players' names and the names of the Team Manager and Coach(es) the same as registered on the preliminary Registration Form?
- Are not more than 10 players mentioned?
- Is for each player a players' number mentioned?

### 2. Passports / Authorisations

- ➤ The Jury will check the (copies of) passports/received authorisations.
- > Does every mentioned player belong to the registered participating nation?

#### 3. Medical Forms

- > Is a Medical Form of every player present?
- Is every Medical Form signed by a medical doctor and the player?
- > Is the Medical Form stamped by a medical organisation?

### 4. Equipment

- > Has every player a playing number on the back of sports chair?
- > Has every player at least two different sets of shirts with a playing number?
- Has every player max. three playing sticks (hand- or T-stick)?
- A player shall enter the control room, accompanied by a maximum of 2 assistants, (Team Manager, Coach(es) and/or Personal Assistants) with equipment like in a match, i.e.:
  - in an competition wheelchair and with stick.
  - in case of a T-stick player, the T-stick shall be attached to the wheelchair.
  - with strap or other medical devices if the player uses such during a match.

After checking the Jury will hand over the Final List to the Referees, the Medical Forms and the copies of passports/authorisation will be hand over to Classifiers.

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Classification Consent Forms shall be hand over by the athlete to the Classifiers Panel.
