## Qualification System European Championships (including Qualification/WRL Tournaments)

---

### EVENTS

IWAS-PCH Qualification/WRL Tournament (QT)  
2-5 National Teams tournament

IWAS-PCH European Championship (EC)  
8 National Teams tournament.

### ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION

The qualification is allocated to the IWAS-PCH member organisation, not the individual player or team.

### MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION

An IWAS-PCH member organisation can be allocated no more than one (1) Team Delegation qualification slot.

### PLAYERS ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an IWAS-PCH member organisation, players shall be eligible to participate according to the valid ICPCH Rules & Regulations.

### MAXIMUM ENTRY PER IWAS-PCH MEMBER ORGANISATION

An IWAS-PCH member organisation can enter a maximum of one (1) Team Delegation comprised of a maximum of 26 members, including:

- a maximum of 10 Players with a maximum of 10 Team Assistants,
- a maximum of 1 Coach and 1 Assistant Coach
- a maximum of 1 Team Manager
- 13 Team Assistants

### REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slot allocated to an IWAS-PCH member organisation that is not used, will be reallocated to the highest ranked and not otherwise qualified IWAS-PCH nation on the IWAS-PCH World Ranking List.

Any IWAS-PCH member nation that does not use its team qualification slot allocated, may be subject to sanctions by the IWAS.

## **EC QUALIFICATION SYSTEM ALLOCATION (including qualification system allocation QT)**

<b>IWAS-PCH WORLD RANKING LIST ALLOCATION</b>	The two (2) highest ranked European PCH nations on the IWAS-PCH World Ranking List, directly qualify.	2 teams
<b>IWAS-PCH EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP ALLOCATION</b>	The top ranked PCH nation of the last European Championship qualifies.	1 team
<b>HOST COUNTRY ALLOCATION</b>	The host country directly qualifies, subject to having a rank on the IWAS-PCH World Ranking List.	1 team
<b>IWAS-PCH QUALIFICATION ALLOCATION</b>	<p>One (1) <b>Qualification/WRLTournament (QT)</b> will be held.</p> <p>The European nations of the World Ranking List which do not participate the last World Championship and not otherwise qualified as mentioned above + 'new' nations which have intended to get a place on the World Ranking List, will be allocated for the QT.</p> <p>The highest ranked European nation of the QT qualifies for the next EC.</p>	1 team
<b>IWAS-PCH WORLD RANKING LIST ALLOCATION</b>	The highest ranked European PCH nations on the IWAS-PCH World Ranking List, not otherwise qualified as mentioned above, will qualify to complete the settled number of qualification slots.	
<b>TOTAL</b>		<b>8 teams</b>
