	2 Time Penalty Areas / Substitution Areas min. lenght 3 m., measured from match table		
	2 Time Penalty Areas / Substitution Areas 2m. in depth, measured from referee area		
	Referee Area marked (surrounded by poles connected with rope) around whole playing field, 1m. in width		
	Spectators Area min. 1m. outside referee area, team areas and match table

B.4.4.b.	Goal nets are transparent and not slack
