1. INTRODUCTION

The 3rd IWAS European Championship Electric Wheelchair Hockey (EC 2012) was held in Finland, Nastola from 4 – 11 June 2012. Eight Electric Wheelchair Hockey (EWH) nations were allocated and have participated:

1.	Germany	(Nr. 1 World Ranking List)
2.	Netherlands	(Nr. 2 World Ranking List and winner previous EC 2008)
3.	Finland	(Host nation)
4.	Slovenia	(Winner Qualification Tournament 2011)
5.	Italy	(World Ranking List allocation)
6.	Belgium	(World Ranking List allocation)
7.	Denmark	(World Ranking List allocation)
8.	Switzerland	(World Ranking List allocation)

The atmosphere was great. Each match day about 150 spectators visited this championship with about 300 spectators at the finals (in total 750 spectators). As Delegates were present:

The teams showed a professional performance and equipment. The matches were fast and of a high level (technically and tactically). Many matches gave close results, which realised a very exciting competition to play and to watch. The Netherlands became European Champion for the 3rd time. Belgium became the Runner-Up for the 1st time. The Bronze Match was most exciting with Finland, the host nation, against Germany. For the own big audience Finland won bronze with 5 versus 4 goals.

At the fare well dinner the ICEWH has celebrated its 10 years anniversary by offering a drink to all people present.

2. GENERAL ORGANISATION

The EC 2012 was very well organised with the endorsement of the Finnish Sports Association of Sports for Persons with Disabilities (VAU), member organisation of the IWAS. The Organising Committee (OC) consisted of members of the VAU Floorball Committee, the national organisation for EWH in Finland. Everything was organized professionally, from opening ceremony till closing ceremony, fare well dinner and party afterwards, from Control Days till Finals.

Before the opening ceremonies a formal reception for Team Managers, Coaches, 2 Players per team, Delegates and Sponsors was arranged by the local municipality. The cooperation between the OC and ICEWH went regular and smoothly by email contact. The ICEWH Technical Delegate steered and supported the OC by providing information and useful checklists and forms, by answering their queries and by supervising stated deadlines.

4. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORT

The Team Delegations were accommodated at the beautiful Pajulahti Sports Institute, a fully accessible accommodation for wheelchair users in a typical Finnish surrounding with high green trees and a blue lake. Every team had its own unit. Meals were served by alternating buffets in the restaurant of Pajulahti. A swimming pool, sauna, sports hall for practice, sports hall for the controls and meeting rooms were available.

All Officials and Delegates were also accommodated at Pajulahti.

Transportation was perfectly arranged between the airport of Helsinki and the accommodation.

5. SPORTS HALL

The matches took place in the main sports hall of the Pajulahti Sports Institute. This was on the same complex as the hotel accommodation, which gave the advantage that no transport(time) was needed between hotel and sports hall. The playing field was very nice, with wooden floor and floorball rink, cafeteria and sufficient space for the audience. Practice possibilities were given in another sports hall at Pajulahti.

6. COMPETITION ORGANISATION

The match schedule was set up according the regulations and passed off smoothly. The equipment of the playing field was according the rules as well. A sufficient number of educated timekeepers, scorekeepers and match assistants were arranged by the OC. Also a match secretariat was available and on all match days a reporter for the matches was present, which intensified the positive atmosphere.

All participating nations delivered one Jury Member and one Referee. The IWAS/ICEWH appointed the Technical Delegate, Chief Jury Member, Chief Referee and Chief Classifier. For the first time also Assistants for the Chief Officials were appointed to educated more people for the several functions.

Daily the Jury Team, the Referees Team and the Classifiers Team have had meetings to evaluate the day and to look forward on the next day(s). Also to instruct and educate the officials to increase the level of functioning. The Referees Team and Jury Team have done research on different speed control systems (Speedometer and Sport Radar Gun).

Two Referees have passed the theoretical and practical A-exam and got their highest international A-Certificate. Three new Jury Members are educated and got their ICEWH Jury Certificate.

Two classification panels controlled the players' eligibility of every athlete and have done more research to develop a 4–class-classification system. For the second time a Classifiers Course was organised in which 2 participants of different nations took part. They both got their ICEWH certificate as Trainee Classifier. All Officials received the IWAS License badge.

Cooperation between the (Chief) Officials was fine. To work with Chief Officials who steered and instructed the teams was very productive and gave all a lot of positive energy. To work with Assistants was fine.

The Technical Delegate supervised and steered the Chief Officials and the Organising Committee, where necessary, and chaired the Technical Meetings.

10. POINTS FOR IMPROVEMENT

- The speedometer with regulations and procedures needs to be improved.
- The photographer needs to receive a list of what shall be on the pictures at least, so that those pictures can be used for a proper report of the event (see the items below).
- Videos shall be taken more professional. The views on IFF YouTube didn't show the matches very well.
- The protocols for the opening and closing ceremonies, as well as the shake-of-hands before and after the matches needs to be written down.
- The protocol for the speaker needs to be improved (f.e. when music on/off, the volume).
- A Technical Delegate handbook needs to be developed.
- Officials outfits shall be delivered in the seizes as mentioned on the Registration Form.
- Nations shall respect the deadlines to deliver data and payment.
- The gender of assistants, technical members etc. should be in the Registration Forms.
- Referees need to start matches on time. If the controls take more time, control-time before each match has to be longer.


