### 1. INTRODUCTION

The 2<sup>nd</sup> European Championship Electric Wheelchair Hockey (EC 2008) was held in Belgium, Maasmechelen from 8 – 16 November 2008. Eight Electric Wheelchair Hockey (EWH) nations participated:

- 1. Belgium
- 2. The Czech Republic
- 3. Denmark
- 4. Finland
- 5. Germany
- 6. Italy
- 7. The Netherlands
- 8. Switzerland, as new coming up nation.

The atmosphere was great. About 400 spectators visited the final between the Netherlands and Germany. The Netherlands became European Champion for the second time.

#### 2. GENERAL ORGANISATION

The EC 2008 was organised with the endorsement of the Belgian Paralympic Committee, member organisation of the IWAS.

The organising committee (OC) consisted of members of the local club for disabled sports

"Gehandicaptensportvereniging Toekomst vzw" and "Sport & Handicap vzw", the regional organisation for sports for disabled.

Everything was organized professionally, from opening ceremony till closing ceremony, from control days till finals.

The drawing to divide the nations into the A and B group was organized 17 May 2008 during the Belgium Electric Wheelchair Hockey final competition day, during the Electrabel Paralympic Championships 2008 in Blankenberge, Belgium.

Right after the opening and closing ceremonies a formal reception for delegates, vips and sponsors was arranged.

The cooperation between the Organizing Committee and ICEWH went regular and smoothly. Monthly the OC had their meetings.

## 4. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORT

The Team Delegations were accommodated in Home Fabiola, a fully accessible accommodation for wheelchair users. Every team had their own unit with sleeping rooms, living room, kitchen and bathrooms. Also swimming pool, sport hall for practice and meeting rooms were available. Positive was that all was on one floor, except the bar room.

The Officials (Technical Delegate, Jury Members, Referees and Classifiers) were accommodated in Hotel Lika, which was arranged with breakfast.

Bus transportation was arranged between the accommodations and the sports hall. Also from and to the airport in Bruxelles transport was organised very well.

## **5. SPORTS HALL**

The matches took place in sports hall PTS Eisden in Maasmechelen, about 5 km from the accommodation Home Fabiola. A very nice hall with wooden floor, cafetaria and enough space for audience. One playing field was available for the matches, which was sufficient. Practice possibilities were given in the sports hall of Home Fabiola.

#### 6. COMPETITION ORGANISATION

The match schedule was set up according the regulations and passed off smoothly. The equipment of the field of play was according the rules as well. A sufficient number of timekeepers, scorekeepers and assistants was arranged by the OC. Also a match secretariat was available and on the finals day a reporter for the final matches was present.


